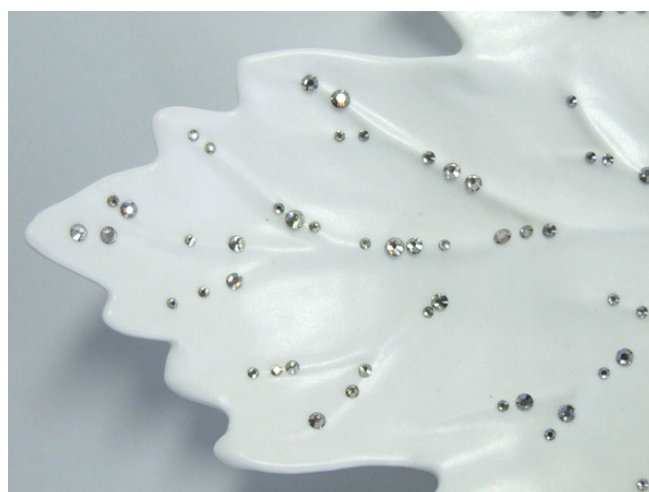
## China in your hands

### Ceramic leaf

Fully covered side: narrowly set application of Flat Backs No Hotfix in Crystal Silver Shade (001 SSHA).

Loose scattered side: outbound accentuations of the leaf's veins with the same article in different sizes.

Design inspiration: the leaf should look like dipped into silvery ink.



## China in your hands

### Organic-shaped vase

An innovative application of various large-sized classic Fancy Stones creates a very new three-dimensional look and encourages new uses for Fancy Stones.

Design inspiration: an uncommon coalescence of crystal and porcelain. The crystals are plunged into the surface of the vase in an irregular way to create a fascinating design.

### Simple vase

A graphic, symmetrical rhombus pattern fashioned out of an application of art. 2028 Flat Backs No Hotfix in Crystal (001) encourages the simple lines of the porcelain vase while at the same time adds a seductive crystal shine.
